### Inquiry into NDPP's fitness set to commence on Monday, 11 May 2015

The Cassim Inquiry, which has been established to look into the fitness of Mr Mxolisi Nxasana to hold office as the National Director of Public Prosecutions (NDPP) will commence on Monday, 11 May 2015 from 09:00 to 16:00.

The hearings will be held at South African Law Reform Commission in Centurion, Pretoria.

This Inquiry will be chaired by Advocate Nazeer Cassim SC, and he will be assisted by Advocate Lindi Nkosi-Thomas SC and Advocate Sthembiso Mdladla.

### Proceedings

On the first day of the hearings, counsels from Presidency, Ministry of Justice and Correctional Services and NDPP's office will lead their evidence.

Members of the media are advised to arrive on time and be seated by 08:45 as the Chairperson will not tolerate any disruptions during the proceedings.
