SMALL CLAIMS COURTS ACT, 1984 (ACT NO. 61 OF 1984)

ESTABLISHMENT OF SMALL CLAIMS COURTS FOR THE AREAS OF NEWCASTLE AND UTRECHT AND WITHDRAWAL OF GOVERNMENT NOTICE NO. 1728 OF 14 AUGUST 1987

I, John Harold Jeffery, Deputy Minister of Justice and Constitutional Development, acting under the power delegated to me by the Minister of Justice and Correctional Services, under section 2 of the Small Claims Courts Act, 1984 (Act No. 61 of 1984), hereby -

- (a) (i) establish a Small Claims Court for the adjudication of claims for the area of Newcastle, consisting of the district of Newcastle;
- (ii) determine Newcastle to be the seat of the said Court; and
- (iii) determine Newcastle to be the place in that area for the holding of sessions of the said Court.
- (b) (i) establish a Small Claims Court for the adjudication of claims for the area of Utrecht, consisting of the district of Utrecht;
- (ii) determine Utrecht to be the seat of the said Court; and
- (iii) determine Utrecht to be the place in that area for the holding of sessions of the said Court.
- (c) withdraw Government Notice No. 1728 of 14 August 1987.

Despite the withdrawal of Government Notice No. 1728 of 14 August 1987, any claim emanating from the district of Utrecht which has already been instituted in the Small Claims Court of Newcastle, prior to the publication of this Government Notice, shall be continued and concluded in the Small Claims Court of Newcastle as if this Government Notice has not been published.
