



CALL FOR THE NOMINATION OF CANDIDATES TO SERVE ON THE SOUTH AFRICAN LAW REFORM COMMISSION

The Minister of Justice and Correctional Services hereby invites interested parties to nominate candidates to be considered for appointment as members of the South African Law Reform Commission (SALRC) to be appointed in accordance with the South African Law Reform Commission Act No. 19 of 1973 (the Act).

The objects of the SALRC are to conduct research with reference to all branches of the law in order to make recommendations for the development, improvement, modernization or reform thereof, including-

- the repeal of obsolete or unnecessary provisions
- the removal of anomalies
- the bringing about of uniformity in the law in force in the various parts of the Republic
- the consolidation or codification of any branch of the law and
- steps aimed at making the common law more readily available.

In terms of section 3 of the Act, the Commission is appointed by the President for a maximum of five years and shall consist of the following members: An active or retired judge of the Constitutional Court, the Supreme Court of Appeal or the High Court as Chairperson. Not more than eight persons who are fit for appointment on account of the tenure of judicial office or on account of experience as an advocate or as an attorney or as a professor of law at any university in South Africa, or on account of any other qualification related to the objects of the Commission. Nominations are called only for all other members of the Commission, except for the chairperson.

In addition to nominees meeting the above requirements, nominations must include the following:

- full names
- ID number and contact details of the person making the nomination
- nominees' identity number
- contact number
- gender
- race
- designation and responsibilities
- contact details (physical address, email addresses and telephone)
- academic qualifications and areas of expertise
- current and past service on boards
- names and contact details of at least two referees and
- confirmation of the availability of the nominee.

Nominations, including self-nomination, must be sent to the SALRC in one of the following ways:

NB: Nominations will not be considered unless all the above requirements are met. Correspondence will be entered into with shortlisted candidates only.
