# FURTHER PROCESSES REGARDING INVESTIGATION

<b>Internal Commission processes</b>	<b>External processes</b>
<p>Consideration of inputs received from the public for the purpose of consolidation into a Report on Prescription</p> <p>Development of Report and inclusion of draft Bill(s) (if still considered to be necessary)</p> <p>Subjecting of Report and draft Bills to Socio-economic impact assessment study</p> <p>Approval of Report and draft Bill(s) by Commission</p>	<p>Submission of Report and draft Bill(s) to Minister of Justice and Correctional Services (Minister)</p> <p>Where Minister intends introducing draft Bill(s) in Parliament, same will be referred to DoJCD's branch: Legislative Development, for consideration and possible further investigation</p> <p>DoJCD's branch: Legislative Development will then forward draft Bill(s) to branch: Chief State Law Adviser, to check for, amongst other things, constitutionality</p> <p>If the draft Bill(s) is in order, the Minister introduces it in Cabinet</p> <p>If Cabinet approves the draft Bill(s), the Minister introduces it in Parliament</p>
