The South African Law Reform Commission (SALRC) has finalised a Report on Project 25: Statutory Law Revision: Legislation administered by the Department of Public Service and Administration (DPSA).

The Project 25: Statutory Law Revision: Report on Legislation administered by the Department of Public Service and Administration aims to review all legislation administered by that Department to ascertain formal compliance with section 9 (Equality) of the Constitution and to identify redundant and obsolete provisions.

This Report sets out the recommendations of the South African Law Reform Commission in this regard. Only one erratum has been identified in the Public Service Act 103 of 1994.
